What is Pinsestævne?

Pinsestævne, more commonly referred to as Pinse, is a congress for Nordic pharmacy students. The first Pinse was organized in 1937 by Norwegian pharmacy students. The event has traditionally been arranged in springtime in Finland, Denmark, Sweden and Norway, although in 2019 it was held in Iceland for the first time! Last year's Pinse was held in Finland.

If this is your first time at Pinse, or if you just need to get your memory refreshed, then here is a **quick walkthrough of what will be going down during the amazing week:**

Most of the days we will have company visits during the day and activities during the night.

Monday is the first day we have together. There is not much program, and the focus will be on getting to know each other. There will be time to play games and talk over a beer/soda.
